A GREAT TITLE

- 1. High Concept
- 2. Original
- 3. Meets a Felt Need

WHY A NON-FICTION GETS TOSSED

- Too academic
- Too narrow in scope
- Not enough author recognition
- Beyond the author's credentials
- Too much editing required
- Too expensive to produce
- We don't publish this genre

COMMON FIGTION MISTAKES

- NO CONFLICT. TOO MANY HAPPY PEOPLE IN A HAPPY PLACE
- •WEAK, SWEET, SLOPPY, BORING DIALOGUE
- PREDICTABILITY
- SHALLOW CHARACTERS
- CLICHES
- TOO MUCH BACK STORY

STUDY THE CRAFT OF WRITING
